Current Plans

The focus this fall will be not only on Greek relationships but on enhancing the Greek community as a whole, with special sessions for the collegiate members of our Greek chapters on recruitment. Afternoon:

Small groups of Chapters – dialogue with collegiate members, Alumni members, Advisors

Mid-Afternoon:

Large group session – brainstorming ideas for growing Greek Life at Bethany College
